

And, fun fact, the top pumpkin-producing U.S. state is Illinois.





On Saturday Evening October 25th the Reformation Lutheran Church has invited Westgate Church to join in a viewing of a movie about Martin Luther at 6 p.m. Because of the length of the movie there will be a time intermission and refreshments in the middle of the film. Martin Luther is the sixteenth century priest who led the Christian Protestant Reformation and opened new possibilities in exploration of faith. Why do leaves change color in the fall? The magic behind this seasonal transformation lies in the chemistry of leaves. During spring and summer, leaves are green due to chlorophyll, which helps plants make food from sunlight. As days get shorter and temperatures drop, trees prepare for winter by slowing down food production. Chlorophyll breaks down, revealing other

pigments like carotenoids and anthocyanins. Carotenoids give leaves yellow and orange hues, while anthocyanins add reds and <u>purples</u>. This process not only creates stunning landscapes but also helps trees conserve <u>energy</u> for the cold months ahead. Understanding this natural phenomenon makes fall even more special.
